ANCHOR

POROS

The next morning we will set off to continue our journey. We will have breakfast, sunbathe on deck and stop on our way for a little swim before arriving to Poros.

Once docked, we can explore the island by scooter, visit the different beaches (such as Russian Bay) or even go up to see the ruins of the Temple of Poseidon.
